Students planning to attend a community college or four-year college/university are eligible to apply, as are seniors planning to take a gap year. Students planning to attend a Service Academy, however, should not apply since they will have their full tuition and expenses covered.

A copy of the **first two pages** of your parents' most recent filed Income Tax Return is required as well as either the FAFSA Submission Summary or the Cal Student Aid Report if you completed the California Dream Act Application. **If your parents are divorced/not living together, financial information is required from both parents. If you can't provide financial information for both, please explain why.** All financial information is confidential and will be shredded or returned to you upon request. If you are unable to submit one of the financial forms, please contact Lisa Neumaier immediately.

Since financial need is only one criterion for this scholarship, seniors from all financial backgrounds will be considered and are encouraged to apply.

Please submit your application and financial papers by **Friday, March 28, 2025. There will be no exceptions to this deadline.**

1. List your extra-curricular activities, providing a brief description and include how long you have been involved with each activity. Examples can include hobbies, work experience, clubs, sports, community service, internships, and volunteerism.
2. Of all of your activities, which one(s) meant the most to you and why? (Limit response to 150 words)
3. List honors and awards you have received in high school if applicable. If your resume has these listed, you can submit it to fulfill items #1 & #3.
4. Please share any circumstances which you feel have affected your personal or educational experiences. For example, were your grades impacted by a medical or personal issue? Have your activities been limited because you have responsibilities at home? If there is anything else you would want the scholarship committee to know, please include it. For many of you, there is nothing that needs further explaining.
